On September 11, 2001 the Customs House safely evacuated 800 employees within 15 minutes. Management attributed this success to their frequent fire drills and training in emergency procedures.





NAVY'S ORM


Operational Risk Management

- ◆ Identify hazards
- ◆ Assess hazards
- ◆ Make risk decisions
- ◆ Implement controls
- ◆ Supervise/Monitor results




EMPLOYEE EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- ◆ Preparation for all types of emergencies
 - Medical
 - Evacuation
 - Leave work area but remain in building
 - Disasters



FOB 10A EVACUATION PROCEDURES

- ◆ When an alarm sounds, leave immediately
- ◆ Alert others to the emergency - ask if they need help
- ◆ (Do NOT use elevators unless instructed by emergency personnel)
- ◆ Go to your emergency assembly point
- ◆ Report to your supervisor
- ◆ Remain at the assembly point until instructed otherwise



HOW WILL DISASTER PREPAREDNESS BENEFIT MY OPERATIONS?

- ◆ Reduce potential for panic
- ◆ Reduce employee fears
- ◆ Minimize potential for Employee injury
 - So employees can meet our mission
- ◆ Minimize potential for damage to assets
 - So assets can be used to meet our mission
