# Federal Worker 2000 OWCP Goals

- Improve timeliness of injury/illness reporting by 5%/yr
- Reduce lost production days by 2%/yr

# Timeliness

- CA-1, CA-2, Notice of Injury/Illness, must be submitted to DOL within 10 working days
- CA-7, Claim for Compensation, must be submitted to DOL within 5 working days

# Timeliness - DOT CA-1/CA-2

FY 1998 Baseline - - - 30.50%



FY 1999 - - - 29.20%

FY 2000 - - - 35.32%

# Timeliness - FAA CA-1/CA-2

FY 1998 - - - 31%

FY 1999 - - - 27.90%

FY 2000 - - - 32.61%

1 QTR - - - 25.24%

2 QTR - - - 23.33%

3 QTR - - - 32.63%

4 QTR - - - 46.64%

FY 2001 - - - 42.97% (1 QTR)

# Timeliness - Government CA-1/CA-2

FY 1998 Baseline - - - 50.3%



FY 2000 - - - 56.1%

FY 2001 Goal - - - 60.3%

All days away from work due to injury/illness, including COP and wage loss compensation

# Lost Production Days FY 2000

Government - - - 62.9 per 100 employees



DOT - - - 48 per 100 employees

Goal - - - 2% reduction/year

# Lost Production Days


Timeliness of filing
