In March 1996, the Occupational Safety, Health, and Environmental Compliance Committee (OSHECCOM) charter was promulgated as a major component of the FAA Occupational Safety, Health, and Environmental (OSH&E) program. The committee structure was established to improve intra-agency cooperation at national, regional, center, and field levels. OSHECCOM establishes communication across the lines of business, ensures uniformity in the OSH&E program, and eliminates duplication of effort.

It is important that each of you provide the necessary administrative resources to support your organization's active involvement in this committee. F&E funding for OSH&E renovation and improvement of FAA facilities will remain with Airway Facilities.

Occupational safety, health, and environmental compliance must be fully integrated into our daily business. Funding for safety and health operational requirements must be included annually in our budgets. AAF, through ANS-500, is available to assist lines of business in developing OSH&E budget requirements.

I am committed to ensuring that the FAA has a comprehensive safety and health program to protect our people and facilities. The OSHECCOM structure can facilitate safety and health program implementation and serve as an effective conduit for exchanging information and improving communications within our agency. I ask each of you to support the FAA safety and health program and encourage active participation at all levels of the OSHECCOM.
