<p data-bbox="235 625 423 657"><u>GSE Assignment</u></p> <p data-bbox="235 657 787 1142">In previous versions, if a user changed an aircraft's identification by renaming it, then GSE assigned to the aircraft were <u>not</u> properly reidentified with the new aircraft identification, rendering the previously assigned GSE "orphaned" (assigned to an aircraft that no longer exists) and the aircraft without any GSE assignments. Although orphaned GSE appear in the user_gse.dbf study table, they would not contribute to the emissions inventory or concentrations because they are not assigned to any aircraft with LTOs. Consequently, GSE emissions could have potentially been under-predicted in emissions inventories or concentrations if the user had renamed an aircraft's identification after assigning GSE to it. This error has been corrected in EDMS 3.232.</p>	<p data-bbox="824 657 1321 716">Changing aircraft identifications maintains the proper GSE assignments.</p>
